We want to say a HUGE thank you and well done to Tyler who has really shown her professionalism and initiative over the last few weeks.

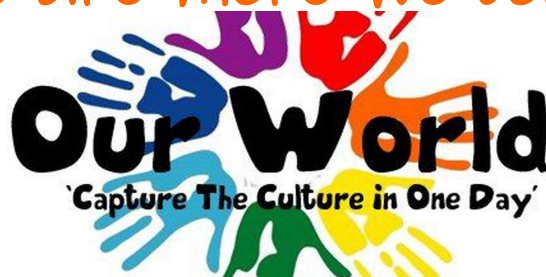
She's going to make a great room lead in the baby room!
