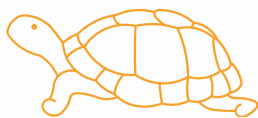
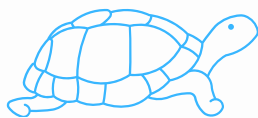
To foster and nurture rich and dynamic learning environments where children can explore and find the paths they wish to take.

To develop a sense of self and interests





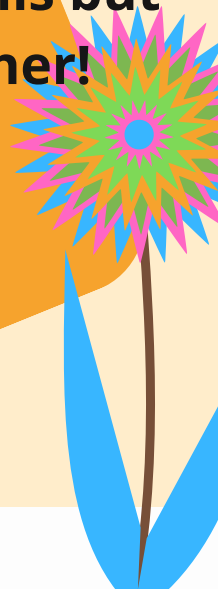
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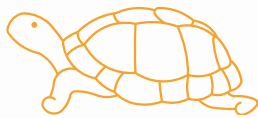
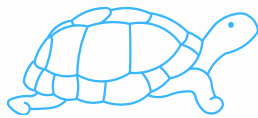


OUR STAFF

Although Rofiyat will be going on maternity leave at the end of September - she has decided to start her Level 3 before she leaves!!

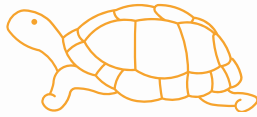
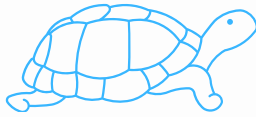
She will have a break from this when looking after baby at home but once back, she will continue!

Parvathy has been working very hard behind the scenes on her Level 7 masters!

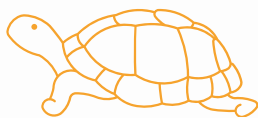
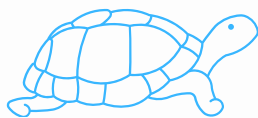
She has just graduated and we are super proud of her!

Well done Parvathy!!



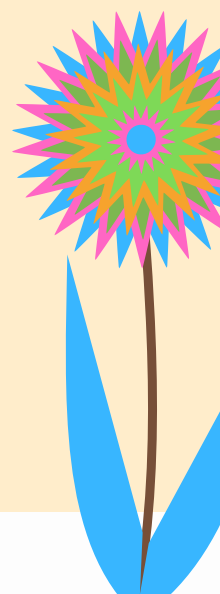


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HOME IMPROVEMENT

All blinds have now been fitted in the rooms. We are hoping that this will help ALL rooms to stay cooler during our very hot weather!

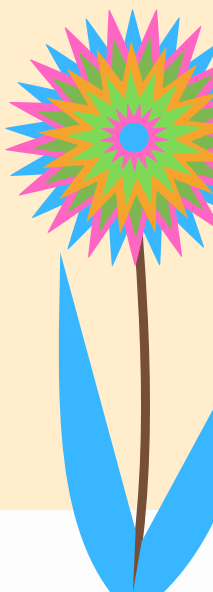

We are pleased to say that all staff and children were kept safe due to the decisions made and we hope, going forward, that this will no longer be an issue with the plans we are putting in place.





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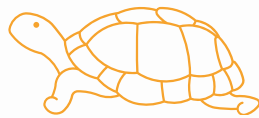
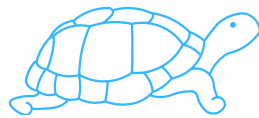


Our Wellbeing Day!

The children loved the therapy ponies and all the relaxing activities that had been arranged. The staff also enjoyed a very relaxing head massage!!





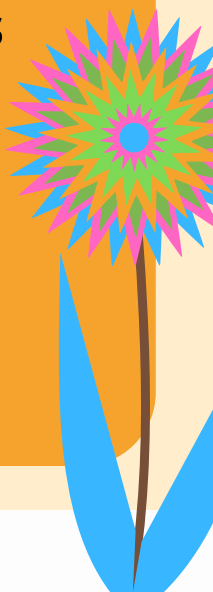
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GRADUATIONS & SPORTS DAYS

Thank you to all the parents who were able to attend either the sports and/or the graduations, it is so lovely to spend these times with you as families.





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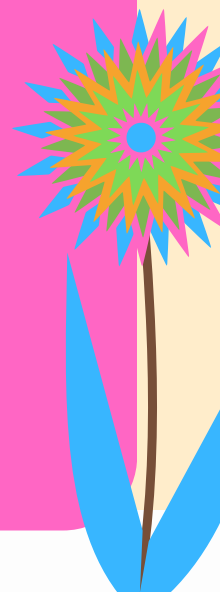

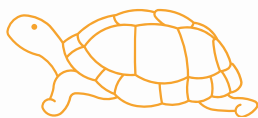
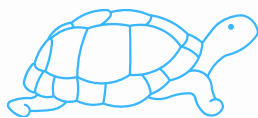
As your Nursery journey comes to an end, we wanted to say what an absolute privilege it has been to be part of your family's story.

Although we are sad to say goodbye we are so excited for the adventures that lie ahead for you all!





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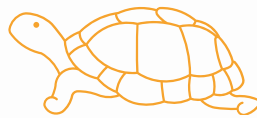
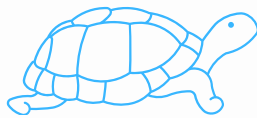
Where do we start Sophie...?
