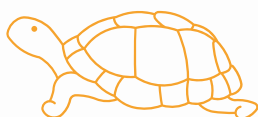
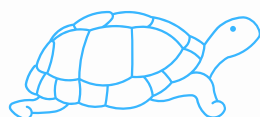
To foster and nurture rich and dynamic learning environments where children can explore and find the paths they wish to take.

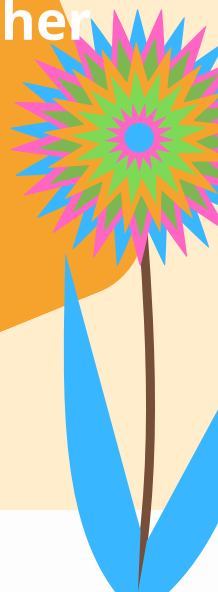

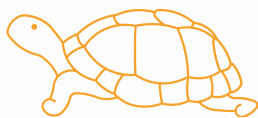
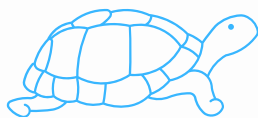
We are excited to announce that Vicky will be joining our management team from September!

Her name is Katie and she has a Level 3 qualification with extensive knowledge of the early years!

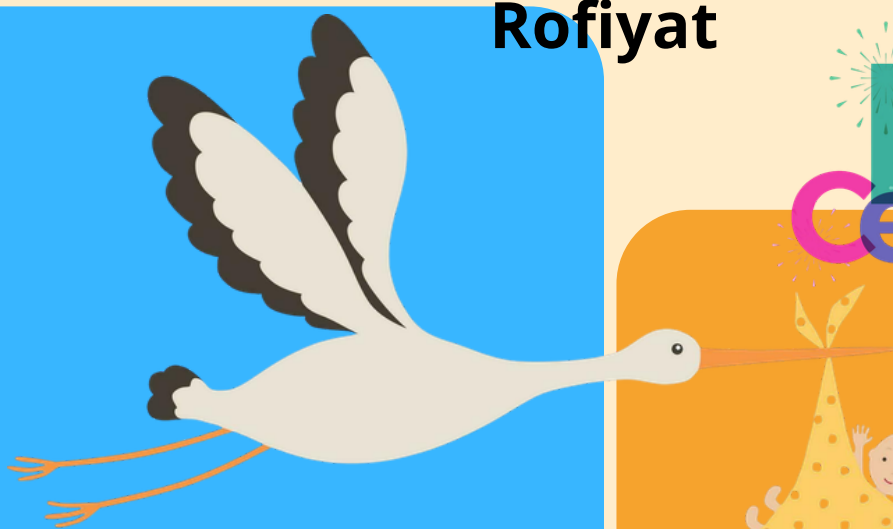

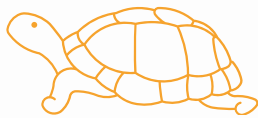
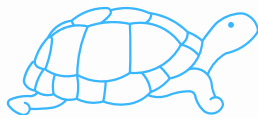


Sophia



We are super proud to let you know that Sophia has passed her Level 2 qualification in childcare and has started her Level 3! Well done Sophia!





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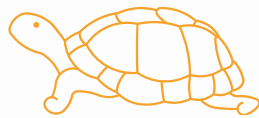
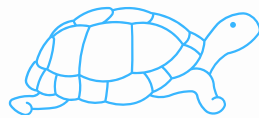
TEAM BUILDING

and Mel for winning!





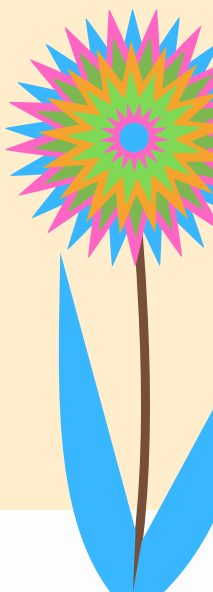
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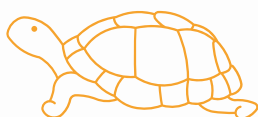
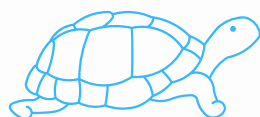


OUR WEBSITE

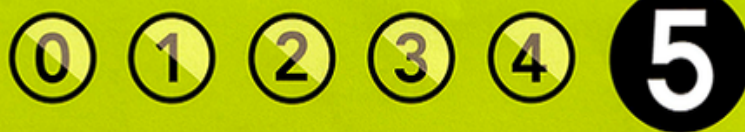
5 STAR RATING

We had our Environmental Health visit in May.

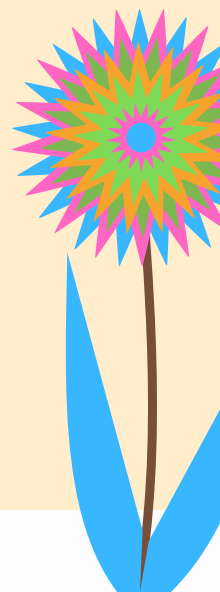
We are extremely pleased to tell you that we have maintained our 5 star rating.

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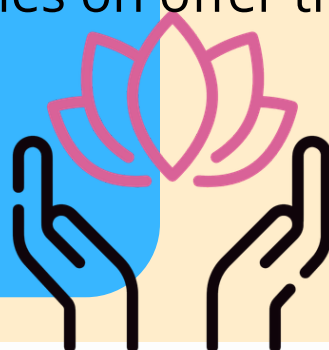
CULTURAL/THEME DAY

Our Inset Day

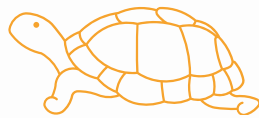
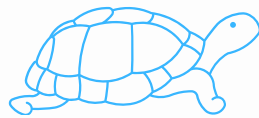
We had a very successful inset day on the 29th May.

BOOK FAYRE

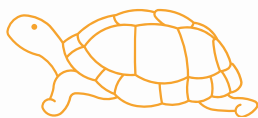
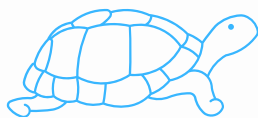


We are excited to let you know that we will be running a small book fayre for you and your children next week!

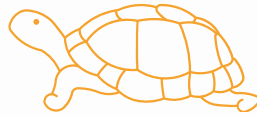
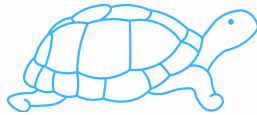
We want to wish all of our children who are going to school the best of luck for their settling sessions at their schools in the upcoming weeks.

We have 15 different schools this year and we know that every one of them will be so proud of and impressed by you!



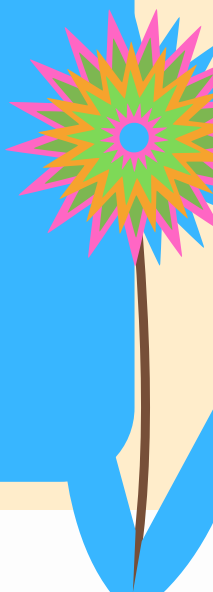

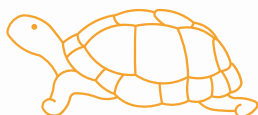
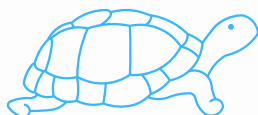
On our inset we had a company come in and install fingerguards on all our doors and gates.

We have been looking at getting these done for quite some time and are pleased to say that this is now a job that is complete!





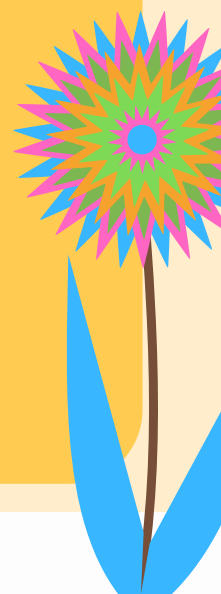

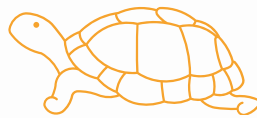
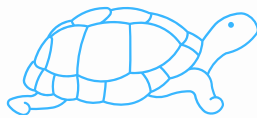


I have to apologise for not having got your May newsletter to you in time.
